We provide information and exhibits on the history of lace.



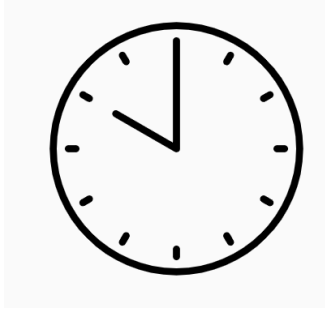
Lace has been around since the 16th century.
